

Journal articles can be a big part of the research and papers you do at Sonoran University. One of the Journals Databases that the Library subscribes to is Alt-Healthwatch. This is a full-text alternative health research database focused on complementary, holistic and integrated approaches to health care and wellness, including botanical medicine, nutrition, homeopathy and more. If you need just a few, quick to obtain, articles for your research project, Alt-Health Watch will usually suffice. It is widely used by many American libraries. This indexing and retrieval service provides a broad but selective sampling of articles, all full-text, from 180 alternative, integrative and naturopathic medical, and nutrition, journals, as well as workshops, conferences, etc., featuring all kinds of alternative therapies and modalities. Unlike other services, it usually includes full text retrieval. Some items in this database are consumer-oriented rather than scholarly; but when beginning a search, it is possible to limit it to only scholarly, peer-reviewed journal articles. Many public libraries, community college libraries and hospital libraries may have this alternative medicine database in their resources.

!! IMPORTANT !! -- CLINIC BOOK COLLECTION

Did you know that the Library has a collection of books at the Sonoran University Medical Center, aka the Clinic? These reference resources support the Students and Physicians in Clinical Practice.

This collection of books are in the little room, near the back entrance, where the copier/printer is located. Small reading desk space is available there as well. These books are intended as "quick reference" resources to help with patient diagnosis and treatments, so it is very important that they do not leave the Clinic under any circumstances. It is also most helpful if the books not be left in the classrooms and instead are returned to the shelving as soon as possible for availability by the other physicians and students on the same or later shifts. The books are marked as property of the Library and are cataloged and shelved by call number order accordingly. Library staff visits the Clinic once a week to re-organize the shelves and check on the status of the books there. All Clinic books can be found in the Sonoran Library catalog, and only in extremely rare circumstances are there books in the Clinic that cannot also be found in the Library on Campus. So if you need a particular book for an extended period, please check it out from the main library.

I want to emphasize the importance of these books remaining at the Clinic as these books can help make the difference in determining accurate diagnosis and treatments. I'm sure that you can see the importance of this not only as a doctor, but from the perspective of a patient.

LIBRARY MYSONORAN NUTRITION PAGES

CALCULATORS AVAILABLE IN LIBRARY

DRY ERASE MARKERS

Dry Erase Markers are available in the Library for a limited check-out period of 24 hours. When you are done with the markers, please return the markers directly to staff, or to the Indoor Library Book drop. This can be found in the Lim Commons, Second Floor, the Book Drop Slot, a metal handle on the wall, is located to the far right of the library entrance (at the east end of the hall). Make sure you are returning 4 markers (black, red, green, blue) and an eraser in the Sonoran University Library bag with ID barcode number. Kits returned late or incomplete will be assessed fees to the borrower.


A TO Z LIST OF LIBRARY RESOURCES
