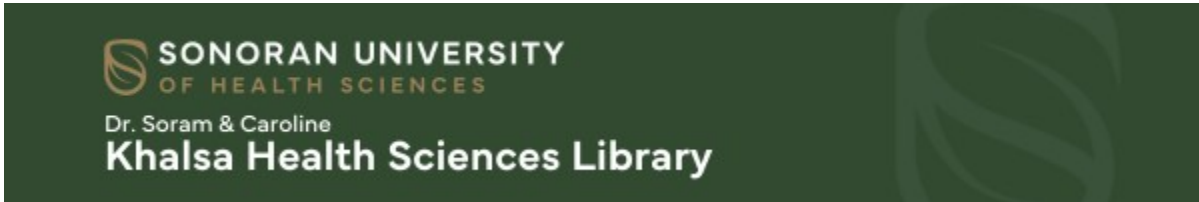

BADGE REQUIRED

Don't Forget Your Sonoran University Identification Badge

Remember, your Sonoran University ID Badge is still required to be on campus, to enter certain areas of the campus, and for printing.



Business Source Complete, provided by EBSCO, is a premium database with full-text content and peer-reviewed business journals. This database is an essential tool for business students. It covers all disciplines of business, including marketing, management, accounting, banking, finance and more. There are more than 2,000 active full-text journals and magazines, with more than 1,200 active, full-text, peer-reviewed journals, 760 active, full-text, peer-reviewed journals with no embargo, and 830 active full-text journals indexed in Web of Science or Scopus.

BOOKING A LIBRARY STUDY ROOM

The Library Study Rooms, first and foremost, are for use when utilizing Library resources, for studying, and if necessary, for tutoring. These rooms **can be booked via email** library@sonoran.edu. This occasional study use can be arranged on a limited as needed basis. They cannot be booked/scheduled for recurring appointments for the entire term; though they can be booked/scheduled for up to two consecutive weeks if necessary. We have two larger rooms for 3 to 6 people, and small private study rooms for 1 or 2 people. Please do not plan to use Library space to attend your Online courses or take Online Exams.

WATCH FOR E-MAILS FROM LIBRARY

We know that you receive a lot of e-mails to your Sonoran University E-mail address, and so it can be burdensome to monitor or respond to every e-mail. But please do try to pay special attention to e-mails from the Library. They could be important notifications of items checked out coming due, or past due. Library Fines could accrue if you fail to return or renew the items checked out to you.

Available through the Library page on MySonoran, this program / database can help with the CLPR courses, Clinical Entry/Exit, and other Point-of-Care Doctor/Patient interaction learning.

Now in its Fifth Edition and featuring completely reshot content and new clinical skills videos, **Bates' Visual Guide** delivers head-to-toe and systems-based physical examination techniques for the (Advanced) Assessment or Introduction to Clinical Medicine course. The site features more than 8 hours of video content. Students and faculty in medical, nursing, and related programs will appreciate the careful attention to clinical accuracy, as well as the range of patient types profiled in the series. Institutions will benefit from the online delivery of content—available for the first time via IP-authenticated or referring URL access—allowing their users to view the videos from any web-based location or device. Lynn Bickley, MD, author of *Bates' Guide to Physical Examination and History Taking*, serves as advisor to the project, ensuring the clinical content and its evidence-based origins are maintained. Dr. Bickley also worked with the professionals and actors herein to present a “patient-first” approach to the physical exam. When paired with the Bates’ text, which is available in a range of print and digital formats, **Bates' Visual Guide** serves as a complete learning solution for assessment instruction and student preparedness for the boards and the patient encounter.

- OSCE 1: Chest Pain (14:53)**
A 50-year-old school counselor presents with a complaint of sharp chest pains over the prior 2 weeks.
- OSCE 2: Abdominal Pain (12:42)**
A 64-year-old stockbroker presents with pain in the upper part of the abdomen, which has spread to the back.
- OSCE 3: Sore Throat (15:08)**
A 17-year-old high school student presents with a complaint of a sore throat, aches, and fatigue.
- OSCE 4: Knee Pain (17:44)**
A 45-year-old teacher presents with pain in the left knee, which makes it
